Minimum Qualifications:

1. At least 21 years old
2. Clean Criminal Background
3. Good Physical Shape. Firefighting is a strenuous activity that subjects persons to high heat, freezing cold temperatures, and hazardous atmospheres.
4. Attend Department Meetings/ Trainings
5. Participate in Fundraising events
6. OSFM Certified Basic Firefighter and IDPH Certified EMT-B
7. Availability to work a minimum of five (day, evening, or night) 8 hour shifts per month at the fire station alongside other firefighters in a rewarding occupation helping others

Additional Requirements:

1. Applicants must supply a copy of his/her Certified Firefighter II or Basic Operations Firefighter certification and EMT-B certification with the completed application.
2. Applicants will be required to pass a pre-employment physical by the Village's physician including a drug screening.
3. Applicants will be required to submit to a criminal background check.
