DISCUSSION – LIQUOR LICENSE FOR CAFÉ IN B-1: Mayor Matthews summarized the discussion from our last committee of the whole meeting and asked the Board about their thoughts of a video gaming café in a laundromat. Discussion ensued regarding closed off section within the laundromat and the concerns for underage children, the gaming café being always monitored. The consensus of the board was to allow for this license. Trustee Marrufo asked about the distance to the school and expressed her concerns with liquor being so close to children. Attorney Welch explained that the board could narrow the exemption for this type of license. Mayor Matthews explained that the Village owned property, 104 W Sauk Trail, would probably need an exemption as well because this could be a site for a future restaurant. Mayor Matthews stated that for the Village to potentially sell this property we may need to issue a liquor license for this location.

Mayor Matthews mentioned that the Steger Administrator requested a donation for the Steger Band Days. Mayor Matthews asked the board if they wished to donate and how much. Discussion ensued regarding a donation of \$500.00 which may have been the last amount. Treasurer Dolasinski will look back to see what the past donation amount was.
